Estero, FL; March 6, 2009 – Over 100 Miromar Lakes Beach and Golf Club residents packed the private “Taste of Miromar” on Saturday, February 21st to sample some of Miromar’s featured favorites. Course after course, Miromar’s own amateur chefs served up their own culinary delights. Delicious dishes ranged from Thai Shish Kabobs to Memphis BBQ, melt-in-your-mouth meatballs to bananas foster, French tarts and tantalizing tiramisu. The event also featured a 50/50 raffle and live auction.

In the end, the “Taste of Miromar” totaled over \$8000, with all proceeds benefiting Habitat for Humanity of Lee County. Vice President of Development Karen Quanstrom says, “It is the generosity of the residents of Lee County that has created the success we enjoy in the pursuit of our mission. Without the fundraising efforts of communities such as Miromar Lakes we would not be planning the raising of our 1000 house in March.”
