Katherine Green has been named president and CEO of Habitat for Humanity of Lee County.

Green replaces Vern Archibald, CEO for almost 20 years, who has retired, according to a press release from the nonprofit organization.

Green, 47, resigned in May 2009 as president and CEO of recession-strapped Bonita Bay Group after that residential development company said it was bringing in a chief restructuring officer. She previously worked for WCI Communities.

Green has been a volunteer for Habitat for nearly 15 years, serving on the board of directors since 2002.

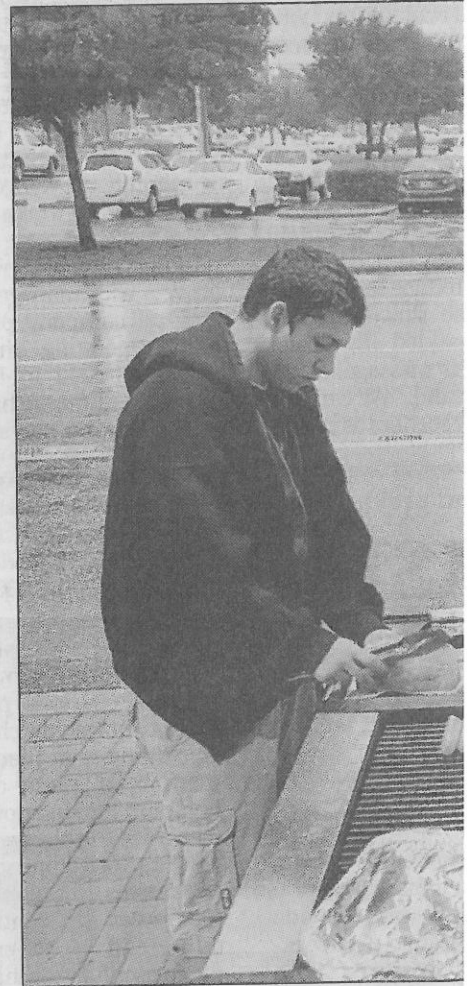
Charles Idelson, Habitat for Humanity of Lee County's chairman, said that the board selected Green based on her history with Habitat and successful track record in business management.
