Miromar Lakes Residents Raise Thousands for Habitat for Humanity

Estero, FL; March 24, 2010 – Last Saturday, residents of Miromar Lakes tee'd off in their third annual golf scramble for Habitat for Humanity of Lee County. Dozens bought up raffle tickets, bid on silent and live auction items and took in a barbeque dinner to help the Miromar community raise money for Habitat's housing cause. Combining the golf tournament and the gated community's January 'Taste of Miromar', the group brought in more than \$66,000.

Habitat for Humanity of Lee County is a non-profit organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing in Lee County. So far, Habitat has built more than 1000 homes in Lee County since 1982. Through the use of volunteer labor and donations of money and materials, Habitat builds simple, decent housing for families who otherwise could not afford it. **Homes are sold to the homeowners at no profit on an interest-free mortgage**, making homeownership an affordable reality.
